#### Weather/Emergency Evacuation Plan

##### Announcement of Evacuation

- An evacuation announcement will be made using the stadium PA system and communicated via radios.
  - All attendees must remain calm and follow instructions provided by staff and volunteers at all times.
- 

##### Evacuation Location

All athletes, volunteers, and staff will report to **Memorial Gym** (Liberty HS)

- Enter through the **South End Zone doors**
  - Doors will be clearly marked “**Memorial Gym**”
- 

##### Inside Memorial Gym

- Teachers should:
    - Gather their athletes immediately
    - Remain **in the bleachers (if able) or on the gym floor**
    - Stay with their group until their class is called to exit
- 

##### Pickup Locations

- **Athletes & Teachers:**  
Picked up in the **Athletic Bus Channel** outside Memorial Gym
  - **Volunteers & Chaperones:**  
Picked up in the **Bus Channel in front of Liberty High School**
