In the event we would have to evacuate, please listen for announcements and follow protocol listed below.

The athletes, volunteers, and staff will enter Memorial Gym through the South End Zone. The doors will have signs “Memorial Gym” to indicate where to enter.

While in Memorial Gym, teachers should gather their athletes and remain in the bleachers (if able) or on the gym floor until their class is called to exit the building.

The athletes and teachers will be picked up in the Athletic Bus Channel outside the Memorial Gym doors.

All Volunteers and their chaperones will be picked up in the Bus Channel in front of Liberty High School.

Amanda Sechrist will contact Fred Harris, Athletic Director of Liberty High School, (610-533-6973) to activate the Emergency Evacuation Plan. Fred Harris will contact Liberty High School Administration and staff inside of the school to notify them that the Emergency Evacuation Plan has been implemented.

Glenn Watchorn, Event Director, and Amanda Sechrist, Director of Team Northampton Special Olympics, along with two IU 20 supervisors (indicated on the day of the event) will organize the teachers and the athletes to help them exit the building safely to get on their buses. The use of the radios and pa system will be available.
